Using midi piano sounds and Flash animation, these websites enable you to play a virtual piano using your keyboard. It should take no longer than a minute to get tinkling the virtual ivories. Go to the Virtual Piano website (see Resources) and wait for the piano to load. Keys on your computer keyboard correspond to notes on the virtual piano. Play simple tunes by pressing the keys on your keyboard and hearing the piano sound back through your computer speakers. It works in conjunction with a free iOS or Windows app, into which you can load digital sheet music. (McCarthy Music has a partnership with Hal Leonard, which has sheet music for more than 50,000 songs. Unfortunately, you must purchase songs separately; a typical song costs \$4).MORE: Gift Ideas 2015 - Tech Gifts for Moms, Dads and GradsA player-piano mode in the app -- which connects via Bluetooth to the keyboard -- will play the song automatically, lighting up the keys as they're played. In learning mode, the app will illuminate the proper keys until you press them. Each of the keyboard's 61 keys can light up in any number of colors, which you can also customize using the app. You can control the keyboard either through touch-sensitive controls, or through the app itself. The keys are semi-weighted and velocity sensitive -- the harder you press, the louder it gets -- but I found them mushier than my own Yamaha keyboard, as well as those of a traditional piano. As a result, I found myself pressing harder on the Illuminating Piano keys than I would have otherwise, and making more mistakes. Still, I could see the usefulness in having the keys light my way toward proficiency. The McCarthy Music Illuminating Piano is currently filling pre-orders, those who purchase the keyboard now should expect to receive it in June. The company also sells a tablet stand separately for \$40 -- it's too bad the stand is not included. While \$500 is on the expensive side -- Yamaha also sells a 61-key illuminated learning keyboard for \$235 -- McCarthy Music's Illuminating Piano can tap into a much larger library of music, which should broaden its appeal. Plus, its multitude of colors would make even Liberace stop and take notice. Ask the seller about the brand, model, year of manufacture, and if possible, the piano's serial number. You can use the information to find the piano's value before you even leave your house. The reasons for selling a piano are plenty; make sure those reasons aren't going to cost you. Watch out for reasons like: "It's taking up space," or "I could use the money." It might allude to neglect, and if they need the cash, chances are they haven't been spending on maintenance. You should also ask whether they'll be purchasing another piano, and if so, why they prefer it to the one they're selling. Was the tuning schedule consistent? A piano must be tuned at least twice per year; anything less could mean you'll soon be paying extra for special tunings or other related maintenance. If the piano is out of tune, purchase at your own risk. You'll have no way of knowing if the piano is out of tune because of serious internal issues or if it's tunable at all. Was the piano being tuned by a qualified professional or by Bob down the street for \$25? If Bob wasn't qualified, he may have made some errors that could lead to an avalanche of internal damage. Tuning and repairs should always be carried out by a registered piano technician. Beware if a piano has been kept in a basement (especially in flood-prone areas) or a public storage facility. These areas often lack climate-control, and temperature extremes along with humidity fluctuations pose serious threats to piano health. Find out how much extra stress the piano has endured, and whether any dangerous measures were ever taken during a move (like leg removal). Keep an eye out for tight corners and small staircases leading to a piano room, because these could up your moving bill. Two pianos of the same make and age will each sound differently 20 years from now, depending on who's been playing them. Serious pianists are more inclined to keep their instruments in top shape because they're more likely to get annoved at minute changes in sound. On the other hand, those uninterested in testing its volume or ambushing the keyboard with a merciless series of glissandos. Was the piano avidly played or was it kept for ambiance? This is important to know so you can find out if it was tuned accordingly. Household pianos used once a week or more should be tuned four times per year, while unused pianos can go up to a year in the right climate conditions. If possible (and applicable), find out how many previous owners the piano has had, and how well they cared for it. The longer a piano's history, the longer you're affected by it; get to know your potential investment as intimately as possible, and watch out for signs of damage when inspecting a used instrument.
